The Mayfield Clinic of Cincinnati, Ohio, has treated hundreds of thousands of patients since its establishment in 1937 by Frank H. Mayfield, MD. Internationally recognized as a leader in neurological surgery, Mayfield has forged a rich and lasting heritage through technical innovation, research, and a commitment to patient care. As part of its historical role in the training of young physicians, Mayfield works hand-in-hand with the University of Cincinnati Department of Neurosurgery to oversee faculty members, resident training and clinical fellowships.

University of Cincinnati Department of Neurosurgery

The UC Department of Neurosurgery, which represents Mayfield's academic arm, oversees the neurosurgical residency and clinical fellowship programs, which take place concurrently at the University Hospital, Good Samaritan Hospital, and the Christ Hospital.

Mayfield Spine Institute

The Mayfield Spine Institute is the largest and most experienced network of spine specialists in the Midwest. Our interdisciplinary team includes board-certified specialists in neurosurgery and physical medicine and rehabilitation, as well as licensed professionals in physical therapy.

Mayfield Clinic Spine Surgery Center

Located just off I-71 in Norwood, Ohio, The Mayfield Clinic Spine Surgery Center opened in January 2007 as the first free-standing center in the region to provide physicians and patients with same-day surgical procedures for diseases and disorders of the spine. The center is designed to accommodate both ambulatory spine surgeries and pain management procedures in a comfortable, personalized environment for patients and families.

Mayfield Imaging Center

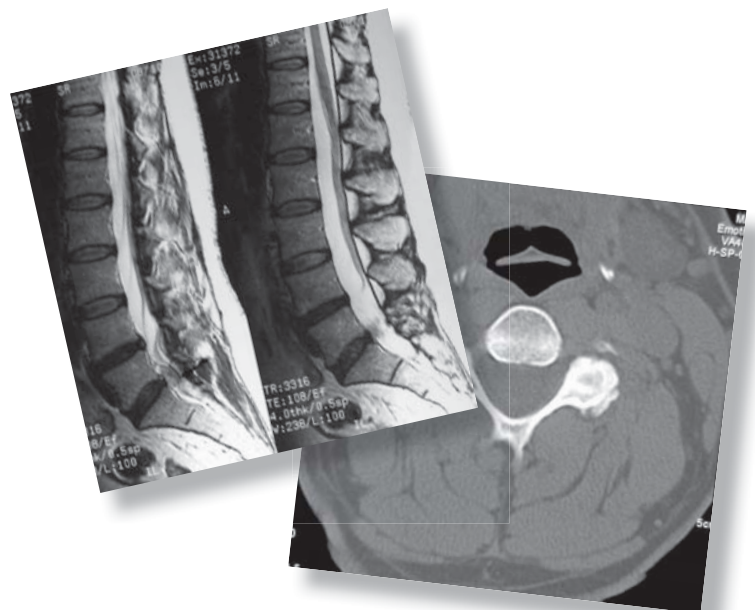

Precision Radiotherapy Center

A partnership of the Mayfield Clinic and University Radiology Associates, Precision Radiotherapy is the region's first center to offer high-precision radiotherapy and radiosurgery for tumors and other abnormalities both inside and outside the brain. The center is located in West Chester, Ohio, just north of Cincinnati.

The UC Neuroscience Institute is an internationally recognized neuroscience center of excellence based at the University Hospital in Cincinnati. - The Mayfield Clinic is one of the largest neurosurgical practices in the world.
- Mayfield physicians have led the development of neurosurgery worldwide. They have held leadership positions in the American Association of Neurological Surgeons, Congress of Neurological Surgeons, Ohio State Neurosurgical Association, The National Think First Foundation, and many more.
- Our physicians have pioneered advancements in neurosurgical instrumentation and technology, including the Mayfield headrest, the Budde-Halo Retractor, the Mayfield Clip, and the Mayfield ACCISS image-guided surgery system.
- Approximately 20,000 patients visit us each year for neurosurgical care.
- Our patients come from more than 30 states and a dozen foreign countries each year.
- Over 4,000 surgical cases, and nearly 11,000 surgical procedures, are performed by Mayfield surgeons each year in virtually every aspect of neurosurgery.
- Through Priority Consult, Mayfield physicians review case histories of nearly 550 new spine patients each month. Nearly 80 percent of these patients are able to recover without surgery.
