In addition to seeing and treating patients, Dr. McPherson serves as assistant professor of neurosurgery at the University of Cincinnati (UC) College of Medicine and is affiliated with The Neuroscience Institute. Dr. McPherson received his medical degree from the University of Kansas in 1998, completed his residency in neurosurgery at UC and the Mayfield Clinic in 2004, and completed a fellowship in neuro-oncologic surgery at The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center in 2005.
